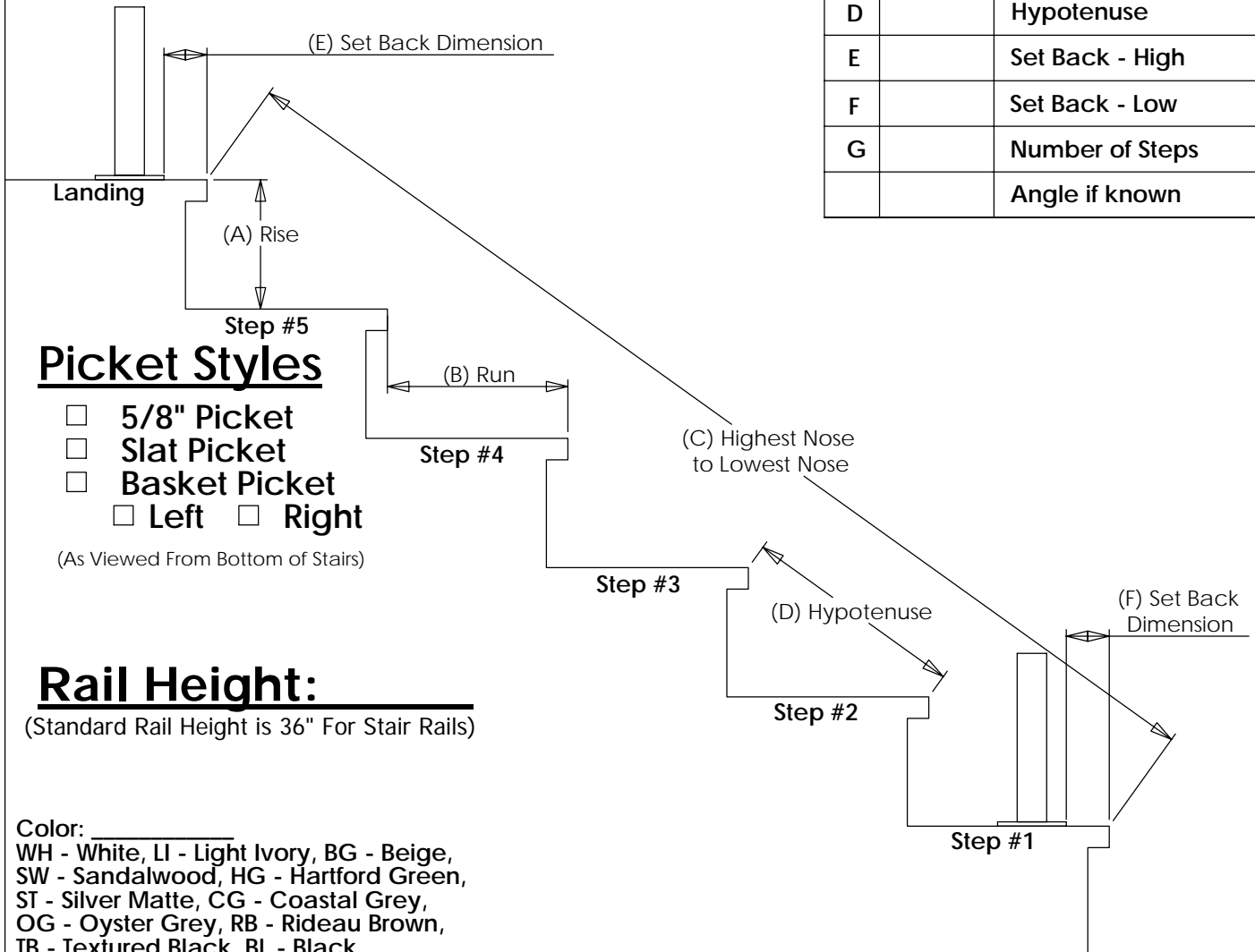

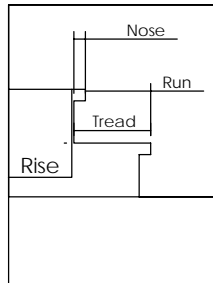

## Definitions for Staircase Rails

Run is defined as tread length minus the nose distance. For exterior stairs the average run is generally between 10" and 14", while the average rise is generally between 5" and 7 5/8". A common example is a 10" Run with a 7" Rise which would yield an angle of 35°. Stair angles are generally between 30° and 40°. Please ensure all stair parts are ordered with the correct angle
